Roger Foo

Professor of Medicine ,National University of Singapore (NUS), Senior Consultant, National University Heart Centre, Singapore

Roger Foo is a Professor of Medicine at the National University of Singapore (NUS), and Senior Consultant lead for the Cardiac Genetics Clinic, National University Heart Centre. He is a graduate of the Medical School at NUS, and spent 20 years in UK and USA before returning to Singapore in 2013. His specialist training was undertaken at Kings College

Hospital, London, and Addenbrooke's Hospital, Cambridge. He was awarded the UK Wellcome Trust Fellowship to pursue post-doctoral research at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, New York, and returned to Cambridge as a British Heart Foundation Fellow and Consultant Physician, before eventually returning to Singapore. His lab was the first to publish an epigenomic map of the failing human heart in 2012. More recently, his lab has published an in-depth analysis of the cardiac chromatin 3D organisation, and also reported the discovery of a long noncoding RNA, called Singheart, which regulates key cardiac gene expression. The approach of the lab is to deep dive into the epigenome of the heart, using advanced technology including single cell transcriptomics and Crisprgenome editing to explore frontiers, in continuing aspirations to discover novel avenues for therapies or biomarkers. Roger is also a keen advocate for the application of genomics to the clinic. He leads the BMRC Rare Disease research programme, SUREkids. SUREkids has developed a clinical whole exome sequencing pipeline which is ready for clinical use in Singapore and regionally.



Bambang Irawan

Professor Bambang Irawan obtained his Medical Doctor Degree from Faculty of Medicine Universitas Gadjah Mada in 1971. He graduated Internist at the same university in 1981. He was awarded Consultant of Cardiovascular Medicine from Indonesian Association of

Internal Medicine in 1996. His Cardiologist residency at National Cardiovascular Center Harapan Kita, Jakarta, Indonesia was acomplished in 2004 and Consultant of Clinical Cardiology was conferred in 2005. Dr. Lucia Kris Dinarti obtained her MD from Faculty of Medicine Universitas Gadjah Mada in 1985, she graduated as Internist at Universitas Gadjah Mada in 1999 and graduated as Cardiologist at Universitas Indonesia in 2003, she was awarded consultant of clinical cardiology in 2006 and echocardiography in 2010. She awarded Doctorate degree in the field of Pulmonary Hypertension and adult congenital heart disease at Universitas

Gadjah Mada in 2017. Her research interest is include pulmonary arterial hypertension, echocardiography, congenital heart disease, and heart disease in pregnancy. Professor of Cardiology, All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India

Professor Ganesan Karthikeyan is a clinical and interventional cardiologist and a Professor of Cardiology at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi, India. He completed his training in Cardiology at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi. He trained in research methods at McMaster University, Canada, as a recipient of the CIHR-Canada HOPE Scholarship. He was an honorary Visiting Professor of Medicine, and is now an International Fellow of the Population Health Research Institute, at that University. He is the Editor-in-Chief of the BMJ journal Heart

Asia and Associate Editor of Heart. He has over 130 publications to his credit, with a h Index of 35. His research is mainly focused on cardiovascular diseases affecting low and middle income countries, including valvular heart disease, particularly rheumatic heart disease (RHD). Dr Karthikeyan is a member of the RHD Expert panel of the Global Burden of Disease Study Group, and member of the Governing Board of Rheumatic Heart Disease, Evidence, Advocacy, Communication, Hope (RhEACH). He played a central role in the design and conduct of the Rheumatic Heart Disease Global Registry (REMEDY) and is one of the key leaders of the ongoing INVICTUS trial for stroke prevention in RHD. He serves as an honorary consultant to the Human Health Division of the International Atomic Energy Agency, providing advice in identifying, designing and implementing research protocols in resource-poor settings.
